





Growth of environmental employment





certified products (millions of euros)**




Number of farms with a biological mode of production








Photovoltaic solar electricity: total power




Electricity generated from wind power: total power



Accumulated evolution of the number of Bilan Carbone® (carbon assessment) carried out




Evolution of the energy intensity



Bonus-malus: evolution of CO₂ emissions in g/km of new vehicles




Subway and tramway network (km)


